ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Faculty of Agricultural Sciences and the Faculty of Natural Sciences offer a structured doctoral study program.

The objective of this doctoral study program is to give doctoral candidates in both faculties a structured framework in which to complete their dissertation for the "Doctor of Natural Sciences (Dr. rer. nat.)", "Doctor of Agricultural Sciences (Dr. sc. agr.)", or "Ph.D.". The program offers a certificate which demonstrates your development of career-advancing skills and knowledge, reflecting the current state of scientific research and methodologies. Being enrolled provides you with the opportunity to integrate into the wider research environment and to form lasting interdisciplinary networks in Hohenheim and beyond.

Research training groups within the program enable to you to personalize your experience.

STRUCTURE

You complete your doctoral research alongside the modules of the doctoral study program in which 30 ECTS credits are completed by participating in a range of available courses.

Compulsory part (18 ECTS credits in total):

- Choice of modules developing knowledge in scientific methodologies, good research practice, and research communication (12 ECTS credits in total)
- Attendance of an annual retreat organised by the doctoral candidates (3 ECTS credits)
- Attendance of at least one international conference at which the results of your research are presented as a poster or presentation (3 ECTS credits)

Elective, training group-specific part (12 ECTS credits in total):

 Choice of specialization modules in which you acquire in-depth knowledge in your field, share your results among your peers in the department, develop experimental experience, and / or work with Hohenheim's partner institutions
